

## MAJOR PROFESSOR SELECTION FORM For Ph.D. students in Linguistics

The MAJOR PROFESSOR is the faculty member who supervises the student's research and dissertation and serves as the chair of the dissertation committee. The student selects a major professor from among the members of the Graduate Group in Linguistics, normally within the first 6 quarters of study, by obtaining the necessary signatures on this form and filing it with the Graduate Coordinator. The choice of major professor may be changed by the student at any time prior to advancement to candidacy, by obtaining the required signatures and re-filing the form.
